- \*1. This could be a tangible product itself or product in an individual package container etc. in the case of testing/ analyzing activities, it could be a test/ analysis report / Calibration/inspection Report.
- \*2. This could be over-packaging made of cardboard etc. that can be reasonably considered as not reaching end users.
- \*3. This applies to marks that have a specific form including some basic description of its applicability. A statement in words alone does not constitute a mark in this sense. Any such wording should be true and not mislead.
- \*4. This could be a clear statement that “(This product) was manufactured in a plant whose management *system is certified/ registered as being in conformity with ISO*”
